Progress Explanation

School level progress scores will be presented as positive and negative numbers either side of zero.

- A score of 0 means pupils in this school, on average, do about as well at key stage 2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive score means pupils in this school on average do better at key stage 2 than those with similar prior attainment nationally. For example, a school with a maths progress score of +3 would mean that, on average, pupils in this school achieved 3 scaled score points higher in the key stage 2 maths test than other pupils with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A negative reading score does not mean that pupils did not make any progress between key stages 1 and 2. A negative score means that they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar prior attainment.
