


In English, this half term we will be exploring several books with the theme 'Survivor'. Based on these we will be writing

- Suspense stories
- **Newspaper reports**







In Music, we will be using recorders. We will be focusing on the musical elements of pitch, duration and structure.



In Maths we will be building on our learning about the number system and place value from last half term. Our key learning will be about:

- Developing efficient methods of calculation (including formal methods) for addition, subtraction, multiplication and divide.
- Understanding and using fractions.
- Applying our learning to a range of problems
- Continuing to develop our fluency and recall of times tables.

In theme our lead subject for this term is Geography. We will be focusing on Italy as part of our European study before moving on to focus on volcanos. Within our theme we will be:

- Using maps to locate ourselves as well as key places within Italy.
- Using compass points and other directional vocabulary
- Look at what causes volcanoes to erupt and the impact it can have on an environment.

In French our learning will be on

'Quelle heure est-il?'. We will be learning how to tell the time and to say what activities we do at different times.

In science we will be starting our next unit focused on mixtures. We will look at dissolving and evaporation and how we can use our understanding of these to help us to separate mixtures.

In PSHE, we will be looking at risks that children may experience in their everyday life and how these can be managed. This will include environmental risks such as road safety as well as how children can keep themselves safe online.
