

In English, this half term we will be exploring The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. If you would like to purchase a copy of this book so that your child has their own version to read along with at school (and to enjoy at home), then this is available to order from Amazon.

We will be using this book as well as other books and films featuring robots to help us to write our own descriptions of robots.

We will also be writing discussion texts. Do you think robots could replace teachers?

In Art, we will be looking at two illustrators, Laura Carlin and Chris Mould, who created images for The Iron Man. We will be thinking how to create our own illustrations considering how we use line, tone, pattern and texture.

We will also be creating collages based around the Iron Man as well



In Maths we will be building on our learning about the number system and place value from last half term. We will also be practising our different methods of multiplication and division and applying them to a range of problems including ones about measure and money. We will be re-visiting fractions and linking them to decimals.

In science and design technology we will be looking at Electricity. We will be focusing on what powers device before designing and making our own electrical circuits and switches. We will also consider how we keep ourselves safe around electricity.

RISE OF THE ROBOTS

In French our learning will be on Les Fetes. We will be learning to talk about dates and festivals.

In computing, we will be focusing on how we can use clear and concise instructions to create computer coding. We will be using a programme called Scratch to help us to create our own interactive quiz. We will be designing, testing and debugging our programmes to check that they work.

In PSHE, we will be looking at how we treat other with respect, focusing on what rights and responsibilities children have. We will link these to our theme of robots by considering whether robots should have these same rights too.
