Adventure Playground Equipment

I would like to remind all children and parents of the rules for the use of our Adventure Playground Equipment:

- The playground equipment can only be used under the strict supervision of school staff during the school day.
- The playground equipment <u>must not</u> be used before or after school, even under the supervision of a parent.
- The playground equipment <u>must not</u> be used when visiting the school site for any other reason (for example holiday club or football matches).

 When children arrive for school between 8.45 am and 8.55 am, they should proceed straight to their classrooms and not stay on the playground or use the playground equipment.

I am sure you will agree that the playground equipment is a fantastic enhancement to the children's playtimes at school, but also that the rules have to be in place to ensure the safety of all users on our site.

Once again, I have been made aware of unaccompanied children arriving on the school site before 8.45 in the mornings. Please be aware that any unsupervised children on the school site before 8.45 am will be taken into Breakfast Club and a charge made for that session. This is for the safety of the children as there is no supervision (other than breakfast club) prior to 8.45 am.

Please can you remind your children NOT to use mobile phones on site before or after school. Phones should stay in bags/coats until taken into school and given to teachers for obvious reasons. Thank you.



Please can I remind you that dogs are not allowed on the school site (this includes dogs being carried).

Please note that due to the administration of the SATs tests next week, there will not be a Purbrook Post issued on Friday 12th May. Thank you for your understanding with this.
