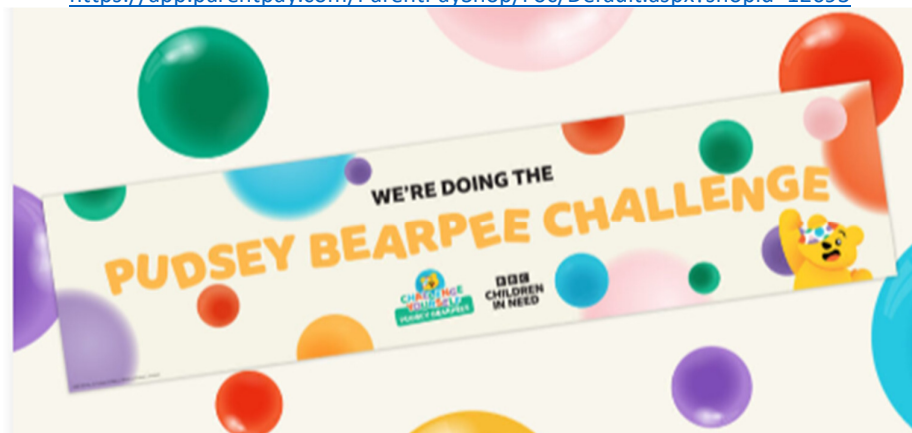
Next Friday will be a non-school uniform day in aid of Children In Need (see below).
