# Headteacher's message

#### Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome back to the second half of the Autumn Term. I hope you all had a restful half-term. As always, if you need to speak to a member of the school staff, including teachers, please contact the school office for an appointment or a telephone call back. School Office opening hours are 8.30am to 3.45pm. An answer machine service is available outside of these times (or if staff in the office are unavailable at a particular time).

#### <u>Uniform</u>

Over the past few weeks I have been made aware of some children not following our school uniform rules. Please can I remind you that children should wear a white shirt/blouse/polo shirt with grey or black trousers/shorts/skirt. Jumpers or cardigans should be maroon in colour. In all cases, clothing should be appropriate for school use. Jeans and leggings are not appropriate and should not be worn. To form part of our uniform, we ask that shoes be black or brown in colour. School shoes should be purchased with the demands of school and running around on the playground in mind. Trainers, if worn, must be completely black in colour.

Once again, Yellow School Photography will be in school on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November to take individual child photographs. For children that have PE on this day (Years 3 and 4) please ensure your child wears their school uniform on this day, and brings their PE kit with them in a bag.
