Dear Parents/Carers

I am delighted to inform you that Purbrook Junior School will be taking part in Swim:ED 2024 programme and a Pop-up Pool will be installed on the playground for the first half of the summer term! The heated pool is approximately 10 metres by 5 metres with a depth of 1.2 metres.

Here is an example of what the pool and marquee will look like:



Children in Years 4 and 5 will take part in swimming lessons for 30 minutes every day for 3 weeks. ActiveMe360 provide fully qualified swimming teachers who will deliver all the lessons, supported by lifeguards.

Further details about the sessions will be sent to Parents/Carers of children in Years 4 and 5 in the next few weeks.

This will be an amazing opportunity for our children, which we have part-funded by our Primary PE and Sport Premium.

Earlier in the week, we had a visit from our local Police Community Support Officers. They work very closely with us and help us with all sorts of issues, including trespassing on the school site. We are fortunate to have CCTV which enables us to identify unwelcome visitors.
