

# Headteacher's message

Dear Parents/Carers

#### **Sports Day**

I hope you will all agree that we had a great day on Monday and the weather was kind to us too. I always enjoy sports day – having the whole school come together and celebrate their sporting achievements with parents and carers cheering them on. A massive WELL DONE to all the children – sports day can be a challenging day for some children, but everyone embraced the day and hopefully enjoyed themselves too!



I would like to thank Mr Baines for his excellent organisation (as always) together with our helpers, the sports students from Purbrook Park School. Finally I would like to thank all the parents and carers for coming along to support the children.

## **Swimming Pool**

As you will be aware, we had a pop-up swimming pool at the school during the first half of the summer term. We were really pleased with the provision and we have now received the data showing the improvements the children in Years 3 and 4 have made during this programme:

#### Year 3

- Children able to swim at least 25m increased from 24% to 44%
- Children able to use a range of strokes effectively increased from 29% to 52%
- Children were able to perform safe selfrescue in different water-based situations increased from 14% to 55%

### Year 4

- Children able to swim at least 25m increased from 44% to 66%
- Children able to use a range of strokes effectively increased from 24% to 53%
- Children were able to perform safe selfrescue in different water-based situations increased from 20% to 57%

We are really pleased with the progress the children have made and look forward to working with ActiveMe360 again next year as we believe swimming and water safety are really important life skills.

# Wraparound Care for 2025/2026

Please be aware that the cost of our Breakfast Club and After School Care Club will be increasing to £4.00 per session per child. Unfortunately, due to increases in staff costs, we are unable to continue providing this facility without increasing the cost. The cost increase will take effect in September 2025.

We will continue to offer places to all our pupils that require them. Although places must be booked and paid for in advance, please be reassured that you will only be charged for those places if your child actually attends.
