Attendance

Monitoring of children's attendance at school has always been important and is also a legal requirement. When reporting an absence for your child, please give the specific reason – the reason "unwell" is not sufficient. It is really important for your child to attend school, if they are well enough to do so. If your child's attendance falls below 95% (even if the absences are authorised), you may receive a letter from me outlining the importance of regular school attendance.

I would like to remind parents that it is your responsibility to notify the school if your child is absent. Absences can be reported via the Arbor Parent Portal (instructions are in the box at the bottom right of this newsletter), StudyBugs or a message left on the school absence line. Please be aware that if you do not report your child's absence by 9.20am (unless in an emergency), the absence, for whatever reason, will be recorded as unauthorised.

Sickness and/or Diarrhoea

Please can I remind you that schools follow the guidance from the UK Health Security Agency which states that children should remain at home for 48 hours (2 days) from the last episode of sickness and/or diarrhoea. These measures are in place to help stop the spread of illness further.
